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ABSTRACT

This study titled "Re-engineering the National Economic Empowerment and Development Strategy (NEEDS)" is aimed at examining and determining a management approach to be adopted to make the implementation of NEEDS very effective. Specifically, the objectives are to determine the extent to which the poor and unemployed are targeted by NEEDS, how misappropriation of budgeting allocations affects NEEDS implementation and ascertain the efficacy of implementation and coordinating mechanisms for NEEDS among others.
